# Cascade shawl 23



#### Yarn used

Cascade Boliviana 2 balls shade Marigold

#### Needle

UK5mm/US8 120cms circular

#### Notions

Tapestry needle Row counter Blocking kit

### Gauge

18sts – 10cms Stocking stitch

# Finished measurements after blocking

Wingspan 186 centimetres Depth at widest point 44 centimetres

#### **Abbreviations**

K:Knit P:Purl Sts:Stitches Kfb:Knit into the front and back of the next stitch Yf:Yarn forward Sl3pw:Slip three stitches purlwise Ssk:Slip slip knit Yo:Yarn over K2tog:Knit two stitches together K3tog:Knit three stitches together Tbl:Knit through the back loop

#### Instructions

#### I-Cord cast on

Using 5mm needle(s) Cast on 3 sts, \*slip 3 sts to left needle, k3; repeat from \* three times more. Pick up 3sts along the edge of the i-cord (6sts)

Next row: kfb, k to last 3sts, yf sl3pw Next row: k3, ssk, knit to last st, kfb

Continue to work the last two rows until there are 13sts on needle

# Main pattern

Row 1: (RS) k3, \*ssk, yo; rep from \* to last 2sts, k1, kfb Rows 2,4,6,8 and 10: (WS) kfb, k1, purl to last 3sts, yf sl3pw Rows 3,5,7and 9: k3, ssk, knit to last st, kfb Work rows 1-10 for a total of 180 rows

## I-Cord bind off

(RS) \*k2, k2tog tbl. Slip the 3 worked sts back to the left needle\* repeat from \* to \* until you have 3sts left. k3tog and bind off last stitch

Weave in all ends and block to finished measurements
